What: Makers Club at OES

Cost: Free!

When: Wednesday afternoons from 4:00-5:30pm.

Who: First 25 students who sign up. All other students will be put on a wait list, we can accommodate more students with parent support. Why?: Being creative and problem solving are at the core of being a successful thinker. Many careers and opportunities center around engineering in both the digital and real world. It's also a really fun way to learn!

How: Students will observe and engage with other makers to learn about opportunities for makers in the world. This could either be through movies, real life interviews, or over some sort of virtual interview through a service like Skype, Facetime, or Hangouts. Students will learn to create idea journals. Students will spend most of their time working on a project of their choice with materials they bring from home. It may be with physical materials like cardboard and tape or it may be digitally on a program like Scratch.

Where: We will meet in the Oakwood Library and computer lab. Students may bring a snack to eat before the making begins. Students need to be picked up at OES at 5:30pm, no transportation is provided.

Other information: Making is fun and anyone can do it. We want to keep the club positive and fun, but being self guided can be challenging work. It requires a lot of dedication, collaboration, and learning from mistakes. Students will be expected to follow along with lessons and participate in learning. Students making choices that take away from their learning or others' learning will be coached on positive choices and given strategies to help. **If behavior continues consequences may be given, parent contact may be made, and in some cases removal from the club may occur.**
